In the garden...

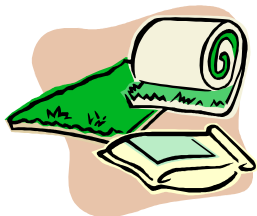
Paula is now putting the gardens to bed for the winter, lulling them into a restful, healthful sleep. This involves the general clean up of the brown, dead foliage that the onset of autumn brings, thereby helping to control insect and disease in the future.

We are also now doing some mulching. We mulch annuals in mid-October through mid-November, but we wait to do the majority of mulching toward the end of December through the beginning of January. That way, your garden will look its best after all the leaves have escaped from the trees.



Looking ahead to the spring, if you want bulbs popping up in your garden, let us know immediately. Now is definitely the time to plant an array of bulbs to make your spring full of joyous blooms!

On the turf...



We are in the process now of aerating, seeding, and fertilizing the lawns with cool season grasses like fescues. Autumn is the time to incorporate nitrogen; this provides faster and better green-up in the spring! L & G Plus believes in planning now for optimum enjoyment and later!
